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Graduated in Civil Engineering in 1992 at the University of Rome "La Sapienza" and Ph.D. in Structural Engineering in 1997, He is currently Assistant Professor in Structural Engineering at University Roma Tre – Department of Engineering. His main scientific interests are focused mainly on seismic risk and resilience of civil and industrial structures and mitigations strategies, particularly focused on chemical plants in seismic prone areas. He gained a long standing experience in the management of research projects about experimental assessment of the seismic response of structures.

He has been Visiting Scholar in 1999 at the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering of University of California at Berkeley. From 2008 to 2013, he assumed the role of scientific coordinator of the Laboratory of Testing Materials and Structures of the Department of Structures of the University Roma Tre. Currently he is the chair of the Seismic Engineering Technical Committee of the PVP division of the American Society of Mechanical Engineering. He is also Chair of the working group of the European Association of Earthquake Engineering on seismic risk and resilience of industrial facilities. Recently has been awarded for the prestigious Chinese National High-end Foreign Experts Recruitment Plan. He is finally author of more than 100 publications on International peer-reviewed Journals and conferences.
