



# Professor Satoshi Yamada

## Professor The University of Tokyo, Japan

Dr. Satoshi Yamada is a professor in the University of Tokyo. He graduated from dept. of architecture, the University of Tokyo in 1988. He received Dr. Eng. degree with the thesis of “Deteriorating Behavior of Steel Members Governed by Local Buckling and Ultimate Earthquake Resistance of Multi Story Moment Frame” from the Univ. of Tokyo in 1994.

His main research interests are seismic analysis of steel buildings and experimental studies of steel materials, members and connections. In the related fields, he published more than 150 of journal papers. He received AIJ Prize 2014 in the research paper revision and AIJ Young Researcher Award 1994 from Architectural Institute of Japan.

He has been an active member of AIJ, Japanese Society of Steel Construction (JSSC), Japan Association for Earthquake Engineering (JAEE) and Japan Society of Seismic Isolation (JSSI).
